Dear Parents/Guardians,

As this letter finds you, it is hard to believe we are half-way through the current school year and the time has come to begin making plans for the 2018-19 school year. I would like to take this time to inform you that our campus, Eula Elementary School, has been identified under the Public Education Grant (PEG) Program effective for the 2018-19 school year. Now the PEG program was created in 1995 by the Texas Legislature (TEC §§29.201 - 29.205). The PEG program permits parents whose children attend schools on the PEG list to request that their children transfer to Non-PEG list schools in other districts. A list of PEG-designated schools is provided to districts annually. Campuses who are identified as PEG have passing rates on the STAAR that are less than or equal to 50 percent in any two of the preceding three years or were rated *Improvement Required (IR)*. Our elementary campus in particular Met Standard in 2017 and also received a distinction in Science according the campus report card. But because our scores in writing were below state standards in the Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR) our campus was placed on the PEG list.

Under the Public Education Grant (PEG) statute, parents of students on the elementary campus only are eligible to request an inter-district transfer (*outside of EISD*) to non-PEG campuses in other districts by contacting the other district in writing. Please note that the Non-PEG district still has discretion over transfer students and does not have to accept the transfer according to Texas Education Code and local policy governing transfers. Also, each parent or guardian will be responsible for transporting the student(s) to and from the new district.
