Dear Parents/Guardians:

The "Adventure has begun" and I hope you are ready to "Go on an Adventure with Us". Your support of the school and your children is what ultimately makes us successful. Below are a few items to keep in mind as our adventure begins in 2017-18. Thank you for your attention in these areas and thank you for all you do to ensure we have another great year!

First, Morning drop off and Afternoon pick up procedures/guidelines:

1) Morning Drop-off

- a. Teachers are not on duty until 7:30 am so do NOT drop off children or leave children unattended before 7:30 am.*
- b. After September 8th allow students to walk in by themselves. You can walk your child to the door but allow them to enter the building on their own to foster independence and help with school safety. Teachers will be on duty at the doors.*
- c. Please stay in your car and allow us to help if needed so traffic can keep moving efficiently.*
- d. Always pull up as far as possible to prevent traffic from backing up onto FM 603.*

2) Afternoon Pick-up

- a. Always pull up as far as possible to prevent traffic from backing up onto FM 603.*
- b. Please pick up children at designated signs and not at the door to ensure teachers deliver students safely and efficiently.*

Secondly, take time to write your child's/children's name on their supplies and especially their jackets/pullovers etc. This helps us deliver lost items back to their proper owner. Also, spinners are not a school supply and unless deemed necessary by a physician for therapeutic use, they will be taken up if they cause a distraction in class.

Next, do not allow your children to stay after school unattended. Open Gym is not for students on the elementary campus. Also, any practice/activity that does not start at 3:45, students need to ride home and come back to the school. The school is not responsible for students' safety after school hours for events that are not school related. If students are found after school or at open gym parents will be contacted for pickup.

Lastly, we do offer math tutorials in grade levels 2nd - 6th in the mornings from 7:35am until 7:50am. These will start after Labor Day and students are allowed to grab their breakfast in the cafeteria and take it to their tutorial classrooms. Please make use of these opportunities to ensure homework is understood.
